VILLAGE OF BORDEN

BYLAW NO 4-2025

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BORDEN TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER AND TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY WAY OF RENT OR SERVICE CHARGE FOR THE USE OF SEWER

The Council of the Village of Borden, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on shall be those set out in Schedule "A" attached; provided, however, that the minimum shall be payable in every case whether or not any water is consumed.
2. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are by bylaw required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such services a rental rate or service charge in accordance with Schedule "B" attached.
3. Accounts for water service and/or sewer service shall cover a period of one month, and shall be rendered on or before the fifteenth day of the month next following such period. Accounts shall be paid within a period of thirty days from the date on which such services are rendered. If an account is not paid within the period of thirty days, the water service may be cut off. When the water service is cut off, it shall not be turned on until all arrears have been paid, together with a fee of \$100.00 to cover the expenses of turning off the water and turning it on again.
4. A penalty of chargeable 3% per month will be added to all water and sewer accounts outstanding at the first day of the next billing month.
5. An infrastructure charge is to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on; provided, however, that the minimum shall be payable in every case whether or not any water is consumed. The infrastructure charge also will apply to all serviced, improved lots, whether or not the water is turned on.
 - a. "Serviced" lots are defined as a plot of land ready to build on which includes utility connections and access from a roadway. All connections are installed to the property line, at a minimum.
 - b. "Improved" lots are defined as any lot upon which is located, found, placed, or constructed any improvement. "Improvement" means all

buildings or temporary structures suitable for residence, industry or commerce, where personal property has been incorporated into and becomes a permanent part of the real property, taking on an immovable character.

6. Bylaw No. 2-2025 is hereby repealed.

The rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee at the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.
